Important Notice

Due to the vast increase of entries in the past number of years to the St. Patrick's Day Parade in Drogheda and the acute shortage of space required to accommodate such a large parade, the Committee have had regrettably to limit the amount of accepted and participating entries to 70 Units/Vehicles onwards from the 2017 Parade.

This is in the interest of Public Safety for Children, Participants, Organisers and the over-all General Public. Therefore **no further entries can be accepted under any circumstances, once entries reach the cut-off point of 70**

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF PARADE ENTRY

The Drogheda St. Patrick's Day Parade will be held on Friday 17th March - commencing at 12:00 noon sharp from the North Road, directly outside the O'Raghallaigh's GFC Grounds.

All Participants taking part in the parade should be at the North Road Assembly area at or before 10:30 a.m.

Please note as directed by An Garda Siochana

Groups walking or marching in the Parade may NOT stop to perform at Reviewing Stand. This is a safety concern and is also disrupting the flow of the Parade

Final date for submission of entry forms and payment (where applicable) is **10th March.**

Commercials

Due to space restrictions, a maximum of three commercial vehicles are allowable and the entry fee will be €70.00, each vehicle. **Full entry fee** must accompany the entry form, as no money will be accepted on St. Patrick's Day. Commercial vehicles may not enter the parade unless the fee is **FULLY PAID.**

Community:

€20.00 Administration Fee should be submitted with Entry Form.

Receipts will be issued/or posted to the entry concerned, for monies received.

The Contact Person named for the Entry should be present at the Parade on St. Patrick's Day and available to discuss any issues that may arise relating to their entry, with the Parade Organisers.

All Floats and Entries must be at the Assembly/Starting Point at O'Raghallaigh's Football Club area, North Road, Drogheda, Co. Louth by 10:30 am. Should there be any change to the Assembly/Starting Point, the Parade Organisers will direct your entry accordingly.

All entrants participate at their own risk and must be in possession of a current, valid motor insurance certificate, which must be displayed on the day of the Parade.

It is the owner's responsibility to ensure the roadworthiness of all vehicles entered.

To ensure the health and safety of the general public and all participants, literature and/or gifts may **not** be handed out along the parade route and the directions of the Parade Organisers/Personnel must be followed at all times.

For Health and Safety purposes **No Bogies or Low Loaders permitted. Standard Trailers only acceptable.**

All participants in the Parade MUST complete the full route, by carrying on to the end of the parade, which is just before the Docks gate: this is sign-posted on the North Quay. Participants are not allowed to leave the parade at an earlier location.

The Parade MAY NOT be used for political demonstrations.

Please respect the private car park at the start of the parade and avoid littering. Thank You.
